Minutes of the May 11th Telephonic Board Meeting

Meeting called to order at 6:04 PM.

We started with a discussion of the communications needs for the range. The newly acquired UHF radios tested well and they will be used for emergency communications between the range venues when needed.

Deb motioned to approve the minutes of the meeting held April 13th, second by Lou, passed unanimously. Tom presented the Treasurer's report, balance at April month end of \$31,547.66. There was a motion to approve the financial report by Ron, second by Jared, approved unanimously. Lou indicated that we're still waiting to hear from the IRS regarding our 2018 tax issues but he has filed our 2019 return.

Mary indicated that Steve has not heard from Dennis regarding the repair of the skeet houses. She did indicate that Steve would continue to reach out to Dennis. Steve was also going to try and get the shade structures completed. There has been no word regarding the Western Zone Shoot scheduled for July. Jared indicated that more testing was needed on the SC range before a final decision can be made on a possible new layout. He'll be organizing his volunteers to assist with setting up the SC venue so we'll be ready to host shooters once appropriate. With the registered shoots still up in the air, it was again decided to hold off on a clay target order.

Steve Ruff has polled many of our volunteer RSO's and with many not willing to RSO at this time we decided that the range will remain closed to the public until at least June 5th. With Ben Avery open with restrictions and by reservation only, Deb, Ron and Tom will contact Ben Avery by May month end to see how those restrictions and the reservation system is working. At that time, a decision will be made regarding our opening date announcement. Ron, Steve and other volunteers have been busy, installing the 24 new target holders, repainting the red firing line, extending the two pistol berms and spreading additional cinders on both the 50 and the 100-yard ranges to mitigate the issues with mud. Deb mentioned that the LE usage has been very high during the past month with heavy scheduling for the next month or more as well.

Meeting adjourned at 7:37 PM with next meeting scheduled for June 8th, 6:00 PM, once again telephonically.
