



## NASR HEALTH SAFETY PROTOCOLS

A "zero tolerance" policy will be strictly enforced. Any shooter who does not adhere to health safety protocols will be asked to leave the facility.

### All Shooters:

1. Shooters and RSOs must social distance at all times
2. All shooters and RSOs must wear masks when they are closer than 6 feet
3. Stay home if you are sick or have a temperature
4. Shooters must leave the firing line when they finish shooting
5. If you are at higher risk for severe illness, avoid participating in matches or group shooting activities. People at higher risk for severe illness include adults 65 or older and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions
6. Do not touch your eyes, nose, or mouth

### Rifle/Pistol Shooters:

1. Shooters and RSOs must social distance at all times
2. Only 10 people at a time will be allowed inside the gate
3. One shooter per table, except Jr. shooters that **MUST** be accompanied by 1 adult family member
4. Shooters waiting to shoot must wait inside their vehicles
5. Shooters must give up their bench after 1 hour if people are waiting to shoot
6. RSOs will disinfect benches & chairs between shooters and at the end of the day

### Shotgun Shooters:

1. Shooters and RSOs must social distance at all times
2. Shotgun shooters will be provided disinfecting solution and a rag to disinfect the throw controllers and card readers
3. Non-family members **MUST** wear masks when riding in carts together

These health safety protocols rely heavily on the self-regulation and cooperation of our members and guests. Currently NASF does not have the volunteers or resources necessary to constantly monitor for compliance of these protocols. As we move forward in this battle against the COVID-19 virus, it is important for us to remember that we will be successful if we look out for each other. We appreciate your trust and understanding as we move through this new way of participating in the sport we enjoy. From the time you arrive at the NASR, until the time you leave, our focus is and always will be the safety and well-being of you and our volunteers.
